

~ Rocked by the Waves ~



Pretty little plaid or blanket for baby

Final dimensions: 70 x 90 cm

Wool: 5 skeins of Physalis (Wool Seed) or equivalent yarn, about 250 m of yarn, in each of the 5 colors.

Hook: n.3,5

Assemble a chain of 173 stitches in one of the colors.

Row 1: 3 sts in the air (= 1st strap), 2 bridles, * pass 3 sts, 8 strap in stitch 3 sts, 3 sts *, repeat from * - * until the end of the row.

Row 2: 1 stitch in the air (= 1 tight stitch), 2 sts tight, * 3 sts in the air, 1 stitch on the 4th flange, 2 sts in the air, 1 stitch on the 5th flange, 3 3 sts, repeat from * - * until the end of the row.

Row 3: 3 sts in the air (= 1st flange), 2 flanges, * 8 flanges in the 2 stitches of the previous row, 3 sts on 3 stitches *, repeat from * to * to the end of the row.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 in the same color, then change colors and repeat twice rows 2 and 3. Do the same with the 3 other colors, then repeat 4 times this alternation of the 5 colors.

Finish the plaid with 2 rounds of stitches on all 4 sides, with one of the colors of your choice, knowing that one of the widths will present waves whereas the 3 other sides will be right.

Block the plaid with the steam of the iron.
